140 Characters or less...

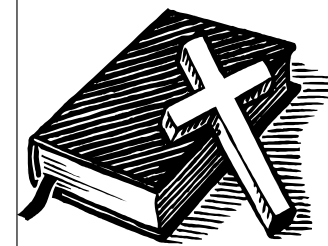

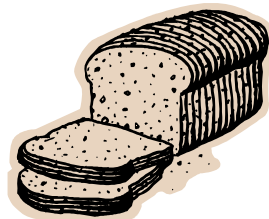
TAPC Easter Egg Hunt

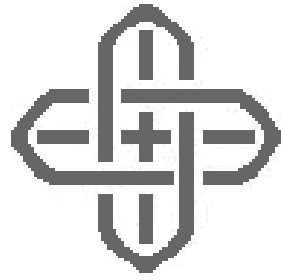
Spring Golf Tournament

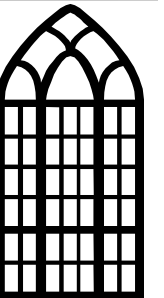
